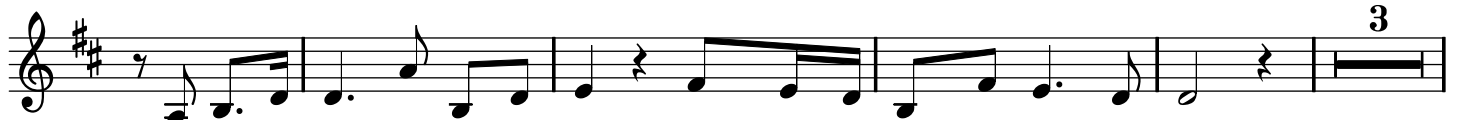
1. In Christ a - lone my hope is found, he is my light, my strength, my song;
